**Dues will be discounted by 50% for the first six months of membership.

The Fall/Winter 2011 Membership Campaign requires an initial 18 month commitment. However, an exit option is available at the end of the ninth month. If the initiation fee was paid in full upon joining, no further monies will be due. If the initiation fee was financed, an exit fee of 50% of the remaining balance will be due upon resignation. The Fall/Winter 2011 Membership Campaign expires February 28th, 2012.

All Memberships are Family Memberships which include the member, spouse, and unmarried children under 21 years old living at home or active military/students under age 26. All Memberships have a \$75 per quarter food minimum.
